## PAD London returns to Berkeley Square

As always, PAD in Berkeley Square attracts a well heeled European crowd, eager to see – and buy – some of the very best 20th century and contemporary design. For its 16th edition, it brings together 62 galleries from across the world, including 10 new exhibitors. Amongst those were London-based gallery Tristan Hoare, which had (arguably) some of the most beautiful pieces there – ceramicist Kaori Tatebayashi's extraordinary clay portraits of flowers and a new bronze piece, and artist Peter Schlesinger sculptural ceramics. Also new to the line-up is French gallery Brazil Modernist, which specialises, as the name suggests, in something that seems to be having a bit of a moment currently – Brazilian modernism. Don't miss JCRD Design – another gallery specialising in mid-century Brazilian furniture, which is also showing a beautiful selection of paintings by Brazilian artist Amadeo Luciano Lorenzato.
